Program Description

Trueblood Enhanced Mobile Crisis Response (MCR) services are targeted to reduce arrest and incarcerations of individuals experiencing behavioral health crisis who could be diverted using community services.

1. Reduction of crisis response times
2. Increase in person responsiveness in both urban and rural areas
3. Increase services to individuals seen in crisis that need to be stabilized, connected, or reconnected with services
4. Provide community training and education

Essential Elements & Services

On-Scene Crisis Response

- Crisis de-escalation
- Behavioral health screening and assessment
- Involuntary Treatment Assessment under RCW 71.05/71.34

Services

- Referral, linkage and resource acquisition to community-based services
- Outreach and linkage to families, when appropriate
- Peer support
- Care coordination with systems of care
- Psychiatric ARNP for medication appointment
